This is the school office and the medical room.



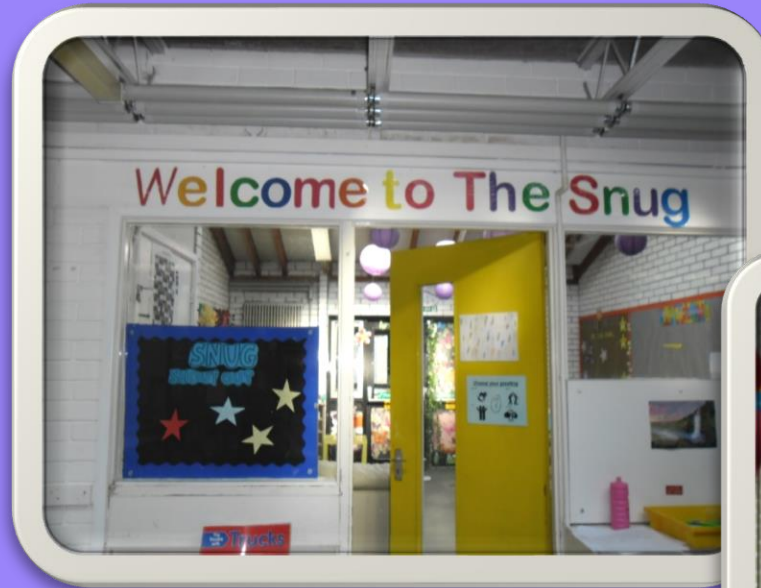
The Rainbow Room
