Book Talk Challenge

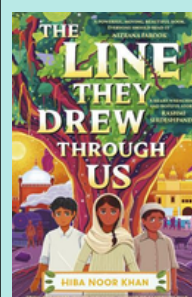


Resources available from 1st May

The aim of the Book Talk Challenge is to encourage students to value talking about books with their peers, teachers and family and enabling young people to recommend texts and share in a growing reading experience.

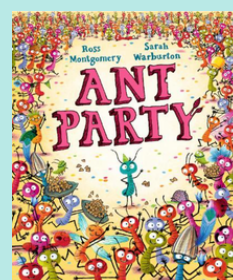
