Home Learning Etiquette and Expectations

- Try your best with all tasks set and respond to feedback – if you are stuck or need help, put your hand up. If the lesson has ended, email your teacher
- Listen to the speaker
- Try to find a quiet place to work
- Avoid distractions during lessons – this includes not being on your phones for anything other than learning between 8.35am and 3.15pm
- All children are expected to attend the live Teams lessons at 9am, 11am and 1pm (unless a specific alternative arrangement has been agreed with SLT)
- Cameras should be off and microphones should be muted, unless your teacher directs them to unmute
- Use the hands up function if you need to speak to your teacher
- The chat function should only be used to ask and answer questions directly related to the learning. It should not be used at all during assemblies (Monday 10.05, Friday 10.05)
- You should try to complete Mr James's PE challenges each day
- Every day, you should read and practice your tables on Times Table Rockstars
- Work should be submitted on Seesaw by the end of the school day – if you need more time, let your teacher know
- Parents should communicate with teachers via email rather than the chat or speaking, unless it is an emergency – this is to avoid lessons being disrupted for other learners
- Lessons **must not** be recorded by parents or children
